## Introduction

This document is intended to guide the Board, Match Committee, and Staff of Rosebud Country Club in conducting club competitions. The Board has approved the contents herein, and any changes must be submitted through the Club's Match Committee and presented to the Board for approval.

These conditions of play guidelines should be updated as necessary and distributed annually to the men's and women's Captains and members of the Match Committee. A copy must always be available in the office and golf shop for Members' reference.

In case of any conflict between the conditions of play and the members' handbook, the conditions of play will prevail. Any errors or conflicts should be reported to the men's and women's Captains, the Golf Manager, or the Golf Manager's Assistant for correction.

All major events at Rosebud Country Club are to be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the Club's local rules, and any temporary local rules in effect at the time of the competition.

## Tom Smith Shield

<b>Event</b>	Canadian Foursomes are played in groups of (4) or (6) at the discretion of the Captain and Golf Manager on the Club's Opening Day, typically the first Saturday in February. The Tom Smith Shield is awarded to the mixed team with the best Nett score.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all (9 & 18 Hole) Rosebud Country Club financial golfing members.
<b>Entries</b>	<p>Normal timesheet booking process. Competition fees to be paid in golf shop on the day. Timesheets will open to all 9 &amp; 18 Hole financial golfing members.</p> <p>Tee sheets will open 5 days in advance all (9 &amp; 18 Hole) Rosebud Country Club financial golfing members:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Course 1: 6:00pm</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Course 2: 7:00pm</b></p>
<b>Handicaps</b>	3/8 of the combined handicap of both players.
<b>Tee Markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>In event of ties</b>	Ties to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Event Background</b>	Tom Smith donated thousands of dollars in trophies to the Club over many years. Tom was appointed a Life Member of the Club in 1990.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are eligible to participate in and win Nett Board Events conducted throughout the year. However, they remain ineligible to win any Gross or Scratch components of these events.



## Captains & Presidents Trophy

<b>Event</b>	Men's and Women's Best Aggregate Stableford Event, Conducted over three (3) rounds on a Sunday.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all Rosebud Country Club (6 & 7 Day) 18-hole financial golfing members.
<b>Entries</b>	Normal timesheet booking process. Competition fees to be paid in golf shop on the day.
<b>Handicaps</b>	Daily handicaps are to be used for each round.
<b>Tee Markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>Competition</b>	Aggregate Stableford over three (3) rounds. The trophy winners are eligible to win prizes in the concurrent daily events.
<b>In event of ties</b>	Ties to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Leaderboard</b>	The Golf Manager will provide a progressive leaderboard on the fixture notices for members to view throughout the event.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are eligible to participate in and win Nett Board Events conducted throughout the year. However, they remain ineligible to win any Gross or Scratch components of these events.



## Watson Shield

<b>Event</b>	Mixed Aggregate Stableford Event to be played on the Club's Birthday (Captain & President's Day). The Watson Shield is awarded for the best Mixed Aggregate score.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all Rosebud Country Club (6 & 7 Day) 18-hole financial golfing members.
<b>Entries</b>	Normal timesheet booking process. Competition fees to be paid in golf shop on the day.
<b>Handicaps</b>	Daily handicaps are to be used.
<b>Tee Markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>Competition</b>	Mixed Aggregate Stableford. The trophy winners are eligible to win prizes in the concurrent daily events.
<b>In event of ties</b>	Ties to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Background</b>	This Event is named after Jack Watson, who designed the North Course.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are eligible to participate in and win Nett Board Events conducted throughout the year. However, they remain ineligible to win any Gross or Scratch components of these events.



## Dorothy Mortlock - Rosebud Bowl

<b>Event</b>	36 Hole Stroke Mixed Canadian Foursomes Event conducted over two (2) Sundays. The best Nett score wins the Dorothy Mortlock - Rosebud Bowl.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all Rosebud Country Club (6 & 7 Day) 18-hole financial golfing members.
<b>Entries</b>	Normal timesheet booking process. Competition fees to be paid in golf shop on the day.
<b>Handicaps</b>	3/8 of the combined handicap of both players. Golf Australia (GA) handicaps on the day of play are to be used.
<b>Tee Markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>Competition</b>	Canadian Foursomes. The trophy winners are eligible to win prizes for concurrent daily events.
<b>In event of ties</b>	Ties to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Leaderboard</b>	The Golf Manager will provide a progressive leaderboard on the fixture notices for members to view throughout the event.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are eligible to participate in and win Nett Board Events conducted throughout the year. However, they remain ineligible to win any Gross or Scratch components of these events.



## Men's Club Championship

<b>Event</b>	A Grade (GA Up to – 11.1)      54 Hole Stroke Event played over (3) rounds B Grade (GA 11.2 – 17.9)      54 Hole Stroke Event played over (3) rounds C Grade (GA 18.0 – 36.4)      54 Hole Stableford Event played over (3) rounds  A Reserve Championship (GA 4.4 – 11.1) Seniors Aged 55 – 69 as @ the date of round 1 Veterans Aged 70+ as @ the date of round 1 Junior Under 18 as @ the date of round 1
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all male financial 18-hole members of Rosebud Country Club with 5, 6, or 7-day playing rights.
<b>Entries</b>	Entry forms must be completed and submitted at the Golf Shop at the time of entry, together with the \$30.00 competition fee. No late entries will be accepted.  The entry fee is non-refundable in the event of a voluntary withdrawal from the tournament or if a player does not qualify for the final round.  Should entries exceed the maximum capacity of 256 players, priority will be given to 7-day 18-hole members. If required, 5- and 6-day members may be subject to a ballot to determine the remaining places in the field.
<b>Handicaps</b>	The Golf Australia (GA) handicaps as of the date of the first round of the Championship will determine the Championship Grade and remain in effect for the entire event.
<b>Tee Markers</b>	Markers of the Day.
<b>Draw</b>	All competitors will be drawn in handicap order for Rounds 1 and 2. These rounds will be conducted using a shotgun start format, with a maximum of 128 players commencing at 7:30 AM and a further 128 at 1:00 PM. A reversed draw will apply, whereby players drawn in the morning for Round 1 will compete in the afternoon for Round 2, and vice versa. If total entries do not exceed 208, the format may revert to a two-tee start in both the morning and afternoon.  At the conclusion of Round 2, a cut will be made to determine the field for the Final Round. Player selection will be based on performance across the primary and concurrent events, as determined by the Club Captain and Golf Manager. The Final Round field will be limited to a maximum of 224 players.  The Final Round will be seeded according to gross scores from the qualifying rounds, with the leading qualifiers from each grade (A, B, and C) scheduled to play at the end of the day's field. This round will be conducted using a two-tee start format.



## Men's Club Championship

<b>Golf Carts</b>	All members under the age of 65 require a medical certificate to utilise a golf cart during the event.
<b>Competition</b>	Daily Nett Events will be held in conjunction with each round, competitors to use their Daily Handicap for concurrent daily competitions.
<b>In event of ties</b>	<p>A Sudden Death Playoff for tied Gross scores in A and B grades will be held on the 18th hole of the North Course until a winner is determined.</p> <p>Ties in the C Grade and in the concurrent A Reserve, Seniors, Veterans, and Juniors gross events will be decided using the Golf Australia countback system.</p>
<b>Prizes</b>	Trophy winners are eligible for prizes in the concurrent daily events. The daily competitions held alongside the Men's Club Championships will be nett events.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Leaderboard</b>	The Golf Manager will provide a progressive leaderboard on the fixture notices for members to view throughout the event.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are ineligible to win both Gross and Nett events in the Club Championships. While they are welcome to participate, eligibility for all Club Championship titles and prizes, both Gross and Nett, is restricted to amateur members, in accordance with the event's Conditions of Play.



## Junior (Boys) Club Championship

<b>Event</b>	<p>54 Hole Stroke Event played over three (3) rounds in conjunction with the club championships.</p> <p>The Junior Championship must have a minimum of four (4) entries to enable a Championship Trophy to be awarded.</p>
<b>Event Committee</b>	<p>The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.</p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>Open to financial male golfing members of Rosebud Country Club with (5,6 &amp; 7 Day) 18-hole playing rights who are under 18 years of age as of the date of round 1.</p>
<b>Entries</b>	<p>Covered by Club Championship Entry.</p>
<b>Handicaps</b>	<p>The Golf Australia (GA) handicaps as of the date of the first round of the Championship will determine the Championship Grade and remain in effect for the entire event.</p>
<b>Tee Markers</b>	<p>Markers of the day.</p>
<b>Draw</b>	<p>Refer to Men's Club Championship Conditions of Play.</p>
<b>Competition</b>	<p>Daily Nett Events will be held in conjunction with each round, competitors to use their <b>Daily Handicap</b> for daily concurrent competitions.</p>
<b>In event of ties</b>	<p>Ties for the Junior gross event to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.</p>
<b>Prizes</b>	<p>Daily Nett Events will be held in conjunction with each round, competitors to use their <b>Daily Handicap</b> for concurrent daily competitions.</p>

## Men's Senior & Veterans Championship

<b>Event</b>	<p>54 Hole Stroke Event played over three (3) rounds in conjunction with the club championships.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Seniors Aged 55 – 69 years as at the date of round 1.</b></li><li>• <b>Veterans Aged 70 + as at the date of round 1.</b></li></ul> <p>The Senior &amp; Veterans Championship must have a minimum of four (4) entries to enable a Championship Trophy to be awarded.</p>
<b>Event Committee</b>	<p>The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.</p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>Open to all male financial 18-hole members of Rosebud Country Club with 5, 6, or 7-day playing rights.</p>
<b>Entries</b>	<p>Covered by Club Championship Entry.</p>
<b>Handicaps</b>	<p>The Golf Australia (GA) handicaps as of the date of the first round of the Championship will determine the Championship Grade and remain in effect for the entire event.</p>
<b>Tee Markers</b>	<p>Markers of the day.</p>
<b>Draw</b>	<p>Refer to Men's Club Championship Conditions of Play.</p>
<b>Competition</b>	<p>Daily Nett Events will be held in conjunction with each round, competitors to use their <b>Daily Handicap</b> for daily concurrent competitions.</p>
<b>In event of ties</b>	<p>Ties for the Seniors &amp; Veterans gross events to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.</p>
<b>Prizes</b>	<p>Daily Nett Events will be held in conjunction with each round, competitors to use their <b>Daily Handicap</b> for concurrent daily competitions.</p>
<b>Disputes</b>	<p>The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.</p>
<b>Leaderboard</b>	<p>The Golf Manager will provide a progressive leaderboard on the fixture notices for members to view throughout the event.</p>

## Men's A Reserve Championship

<b>Event</b>	54 Hole Stroke Event played over three (3) rounds in conjunction with the club championships. For players that fall into the handicap range as indicated. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A Reserve (GA 4.4 - 11.1)</li></ul>
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all male financial 18-hole members of Rosebud Country Club with 5, 6, or 7-day playing rights.
<b>Entries</b>	Covered by Club Championship Entry.
<b>Tee markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>Draw</b>	Refer to Men's Club Championship Conditions of Play.
<b>Competition</b>	Daily Nett Events will be held in conjunction with each round, competitors to use their <b>Daily Handicap</b> for daily concurrent competitions.
<b>In event of ties</b>	Ties for the A Reserve gross event to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Leaderboard</b>	The Golf Manager will provide a progressive leaderboard on the fixture notices for members to view throughout the event.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are ineligible to win both Gross and Nett events in the Club Championships. While they are welcome to participate, eligibility for all Club Championship titles and prizes, both Gross and Nett, is restricted to amateur members, in accordance with the event's Conditions of Play.



## Men's Matchplay Championship

<b>Event</b>	Scratch Matchplay for each Championship Grade, played over three (3) rounds. The top eight (8) gross scores from each of the Championship Grades (A,B,C) will qualify for the matchplay championship.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all Rosebud Country Club 18-hole financial golfing members.
<b>Entries</b>	Covered by Club Championship Entry Fee.
<b>Tee markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>Draw</b>	<p>The Matchplay Draw will be posted in the golf shop, on the club's website, and sent to all players via email by the Golf Manager or their assistants.</p> <p>The first named player on the draw is responsible for contacting their opponent to arrange a suitable time for the match. Matches must be completed on or by the dates indicated on the Draw. Please ensure that match results are entered on the draw sheet in the golf shop.</p> <p>If a player is unable to complete their match by the designated date, they will forfeit to their opponent. A request for an extension may be submitted to the Club Captain or Golf Manager. The final for each grade will be scheduled on a Saturday, as determined by the Captain and Golf Manager.</p>
<b>Competition</b>	The specific rules for Matchplay, as stated in the Rules of Golf, should be followed. Matchplay competitors are not eligible to compete in the concurrent competition of the day or the Nearest the Pin competitions.
<b>In event of ties</b>	The Golf Australia Countback System will be used for deciding qualifiers in the case of ties. For Matchplay rounds, if a match is "all square" after 18 holes, the match shall continue from the first hole played until one player gains the advantage by winning a hole
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are eligible to participate in and win Nett Board Events conducted throughout the year. However, they remain ineligible to win any Gross or Scratch components of these events.



## Men's Foursomes Championship

<b>Event</b>	A 36-hole Foursomes Stroke Event played on one Saturday, including a concurrent Nett Event.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to Rosebud Country Club financial golfing members with (7 Day) 18 hole playing rights.
<b>Entries</b>	Entry Forms, Competition Fees to be paid in golf shop at the time of entry. No late entries will be accepted.
<b>Handicaps</b>	The Championship Handicap is to be HALF of both partner's aggregate daily handicap. This is to be used for both rounds and for the daily concurrent event.
<b>Tee markers</b>	Markers of the day.
<b>Competition</b>	In Foursomes, partners alternate hitting from different tees and continue to alternate shots until the hole is completed. Penalty strokes do not affect the order of play. For the second round on the same course, the order of play is reversed. Scoring is conducted as in a stroke play round.
<b>Prizes</b>	The Gross and Nett trophies can be won by the same team.
<b>In event of ties</b>	A Sudden Death Playoff for tied Gross scores will be held on the 18th hole of the North Course until a winner is determined.  Ties for the concurrent nett event to be determined by the Golf Australia count back system.
<b>Disputes</b>	The Event Committee shall settle any dispute or protest, which must be submitted in writing to the Golf Shop no later than 15 minutes after close of play on the day. Their decision will be final. In the absence of the full Event Committee, such members as thereof may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Event Committee.
<b>Leaderboard</b>	The Golf Manager will provide a progressive leaderboard on the fixture notices for members to view throughout the event.
<b>Special Conditions</b>	PGA Vocational Members, Tournament Members, Associate Members, and Affiliate Members are eligible to participate in and win Nett Board Events conducted throughout the year. However, they remain ineligible to win any Gross or Scratch components of these events.



## Men's Midweek Nett Championship

<b>Event</b>	A 36-hole Stroke (Nett) Event played over two (2) weeks.
<b>Event Committee</b>	The Event Committee shall comprise members of the Match Committee, the Golf Manager, or the Assistant Golf Manager. The Event Committee reserves the right to alter, delay, postpone, reduce, or transfer the round if required.

## 4BBB Competition Conditions of Play

<b>Format</b>	The 4BBB (Four Ball Best Ball) is a team competition where two players partner together, and each player plays their own ball. The better score of the two on each hole is recorded as the team's score.
<b>Group Pairing</b>	<p><b>Groups of Two:</b> Players who are in groups of two will be randomly paired with other groups of two to maintain the integrity of the competition. This ensures that all players have a fair and consistent experience throughout the event.</p> <p><b>Groups of Three:</b> In the case of groups of three, the lowest marker (the player with the lowest handicap) will serve as the "swinger" and will partner with the other two players. This means the swinger's score can count for both of their partners.</p>
<b>Scoring Instructions</b>	The lowest marker in a group of three must be placed in cell #1 in the MiClub booking system. This is crucial for ensuring that the scoring system correctly calculates the swinger's score for the other two players.



## Competition Conditions of Play

### Temporary Holes – Ineligibility for Special Prizes

The Golf & Grounds Committee has determined that Eagles, Hole-in-Ones, and Albatrosses achieved on temporary holes shall not be eligible for special prizes or prize payouts.

This condition applies to all forms of play, including both competition and social rounds, whenever temporary holes are in use.

This ruling forms part of the official Rosebud Country Club Conditions of Play and is effective from Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
