



Women's Medal Prize Breakdown – Process Guide

(Minimum 6 Players Required to Award the Medal)

1. Nearest the Pin (NTP) Allocation

- **Two (2) NTPs** must be awarded each morning, regardless of the number of participants in the Women's competition.

2. Adjusting Prizes Based on Numbers

- If the number of participants falls below the required threshold for standard prize allocation:
 - One \$10 prize **from the placegetters down the line** will be reallocated to ensure the **second NTP** is still awarded.

3. Grade Splits

- Women's grades must be split **evenly and consistently with the Men's competition** grading structure.

4. Tuesday Medal Prize Allocation

- For **Tuesday Medal competitions**, additional prizes are included as part of the overall prize pool. These are also taken from the placegetters down the line. The extra prizes are:
 - **Overall Winner** – Receives the **Medal** plus is recognized as the **Graded Winner**.
 - **Gross Winner** – \$10.00 prize.
 - **Putting Winner** – \$10.00 prize.

5. Running the Putting Report

To identify the Putting Winner:

1. Go to **Reports**.
2. Click **Custom Report**.
3. Select **MiScore**.
4. Click **Run**.
5. Enter the **date of play**.
6. Click **Excel** to export.
7. **Sort by putts**, ensuring you **expand the selection** to maintain data accuracy.
8. Identify the winner with the **lowest number of putts**.
