



Ambrose Rules of Play

2 Person Ambrose

Format Guidelines

In this format, each player must play a tee shot on every hole. The scorer is responsible for accurately recording whose tee shot is used on each hole.

After both players have hit their tee shots, the team captain selects the preferred drive. This ball may be marked, lifted, and cleaned. The other players retrieve their balls, and all players then play their next shot from within one club length of the selected ball's position.

Preferred lies are permitted within one club length, but the ball must remain in the same type of lie. For example, if the selected ball is in the rough, the next shot must also be played from the rough.

On the putting green, balls must be placed within one hand span of the selected spot, no closer to the hole.

This process of selecting the best ball continues until one is holed. Once a ball is holed out, no further strokes are allowed on that hole.

Minimum Drives Required: 7 Drives Per Player
