



Canadian Foursomes

Format Overview

Canadian Foursomes is a fun and strategic variation of golf, played in pairs.

Here's how it works:

- **Teams:** Two players form a team and compete against other pairs.
- **Tee Shots:** Both players hit a tee shot on every hole.
- **Selection:** The team selects the best tee shot, and the other player (whose shot wasn't chosen) hits the next shot.
- **Alternate Shots:** After the second shot, teammates take turns hitting the ball until it is holed.
- **No Minimum Drives:** There is no requirement for a minimum number of tee shots to be used by each player.
- **Handicap:** The team's handicap is calculated as **3/8 of the combined handicap** of both players.

The format emphasizes teamwork and strategy, choosing the best tee shot is crucial to setting up for the rest of the hole.
