



Rosebud Country Club Driving Range Rules

1. Irons Only - Maximum Distance 200 Metres

Players MUST not hit shots beyond 200 metres to ensure the safety of golfers playing on the 17th and 18th holes of the North Course. Violations of this rule could result in suspension from the facility.

2. Ball Collection

It is strongly advised that players do NOT collect balls from the chipping greens. Doing so is at their own risk, and the club is not responsible for any injuries or incidents that may occur.

3. Use of Range Balls

Only range balls provided by Rosebud Country Club may be used on the driving range. Personal golf balls are not permitted.

4. Respect for Other Players

Be mindful of others using the facility. Ensure a safe distance between yourself and other players when swinging and avoid causing distractions.

5. Stay within Designated Areas

Always stay within the designated hitting area. Do not walk onto the range beyond the designated hitting mats.

6. Proper Disposal of Baskets

Return all ball baskets to the designated collection points after use.

7. Chipping and Putting Green Etiquette

When using the chipping and putting greens, respect others practicing by sharing the space and not disrupting their play.

8. Use of Equipment

Ensure all equipment (golf clubs, bags, etc.) and do not obstruct other players or walkways.

9. Children Supervision

Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult at all times while using the driving range and practice facilities.

10. Dress Code

Players must adhere to the club's dress code, ensuring appropriate golf attire is worn at all times while using the range.
